# Petra Scholé Classical Community

*In essentials, unity, in nonessentials liberty, in all things charity. St. Augustine*

**Vision Statement:** To create a Christian learning community seeking to nurture wisdom and virtue in our members, through a classical education, for God's glory.

**Group organization:** We are a Christian community of classically educating families committed to nurturing wisdom and virtue in our children. We believe this cannot be done apart from the Spirit of God, therefore Christ is at the center of all we do. We are affiliated with Classical Academic Press Scholé groups, a leader in the modern classical education renewal, but we are locally organized and managed. We are headed by a leadership team, who manage our community. Each family has final authority over how they manage their own homeschool but submits to the requirements of Petra Scholé on the community day. The success of our community depends upon the collective ideas and involvement of all our families. We believe in building a strong community through mutual relationships and support, thus we request that all moms attend our Mother Culture hour (from 8:00am - 9:00am on community day, which is Monday) and parent(s) be present on community day either to mentor, assist or in some other way contribute to the running of the community. Parents of elementary age children must be on campus whenever their child is present. Parents of junior high and high school students are encouraged to be present as much as possible. We understand circumstances may arise that prevent parents from always being on campus. Please talk to one of the leadership team regarding extenuating circumstances on a case by case basis.

### **Membership Application Process:**

Admission into the Petra Scholé Classical Community is a three-step process. The purpose of the application and interview process is to ensure, prior to enrollment, that families understand and align with our vision and that a solid partnership is fostered.

**Step 1 - Application:** Applications from new families will be accepted beginning March 15. Interested families will complete the application and return to the Community Director. Once received, we will contact you to arrange an interview.

**Step 2 - Interview:** In order to determine if the environment, expectations and curriculum are a good fit for the applying family, we will interview all applicants. Once the interview is complete, we will notify you via email within 48 hours of your enrollment status.

**Step 3 - Registration:** Once your enrollment is approved, you will need to register your children, pay registration fees and indicate what classes students want to be enrolled in. Some classes may be scheduled according to demand, so flexibility to change elective classes may be required if demand does not justify scheduling a desired class. Because we believe the liberal arts are the center of a classical education, and the core classes are where the students will learn the language arts (or the Trivium), we require that every student enroll in a minimum of the core classes for their age.

**Core classes are the prerequisite to take elective classes.**

**Financial Responsibilities:**

- \$100 non-refundable Enrollment fee per family (due with Registration Form)
- \$150 fee for insurance and rent to host church per family (due with Registration Form)
- \$50 non-refundable supply fee per child (due with Registration Form)
- Additional supply fee may be required for High School science
- All fees listed are per year unless otherwise noted
- Elementary (K-6) Core: \$400 (includes 8am Story Time or Calisthenics)
- Elementary (K-6) Core Plus: \$500
- Elementary (K-6) Full Day: \$700
- Middle School (7-8) Core: \$550
- Middle School academic electives (Latin, Math, Science, Geography, and CE/Mock Trial): \$150 each
- Middle School/High School Calisthenics: \$100
- High School (9-12) Core: \$650
- High School (9-12) electives: \$150 each (\$75 if the class is just one semester)

*We desire transparency and accountability in stewardship of our resources. 100% of tuition is used to pay mentors and our director. Supply fee will be used to purchase supplies for the whole community, as well as printing and other necessary expenses. Additional supply fees for high school science will be used to purchase lab equipment. Tuition and fees are due no later than Aug 15. Tuition is non-refundable after classes begin. Required curriculum and books for family use are not included in the tuition fee. Families will be provided a list of required books and curriculum as well as sources where these materials can be purchased.*
