\* It is important for our students to have some exposure and study of Latin and we prefer for that to be the only language option for elementary and middle school. However, in order to provide another option for those students with challenges too great to work through with Latin studies, students may opt for sign language, with approval from the Director.

2022/2023 Class Grid and Fee Schedule continued

Core classes are the prerequisite to elective classes. If there are 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade students, in a family that has other students registered for Core (partner families), exceptions may be considered by Board discretion, for those older high school students to enroll in electives only. 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> high school students of families not enrolled in Core (participant families) will be allowed to register for elective classes on a waitlist basis. Families seeking this option will be informed by May 1 if their enrollment is accepted. Please submit written requests for exception to the Director for Board consideration.

Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment of 5 students may not be offered.

**Registration Fee:** If registered by 3/31/22, \$50/family for returning families. After 4/1/22, \$75/family for returning families. \$100/family for new families.

**Facility/Insurance Fee:** \$150/family enrolling in Core, \$75 for upperclassmen enrolling in electives only.

**Supply Fee:** \$50/student. There may be an additional supply fee for some classes, which will be communicated asap.

Registration, Facility/Insurance and Supply fees are to be paid in full with registration.

**Drop dates:** Classes may be withdrawn without charge within the first 3 weeks of the semester. All class changes or modifications need to be communicated to the Director in writing (text and email are fine.) Tuition is not prorated due to illness, vacation, or family outings.

**Tuition- Tuition fees stated are per semester, per student.** Tuition invoices will be sent after the drop date each semester, payable upon receipt.

All payments for fees and tuition must be paid via Cash, Check or Cashiers Check. We do not have the ability to accept paypal, venmo or credit cards for these fees at this time. Registration fee is non-refundable. Other fees are refundable if enrollment is withdrawn before week one.
